2015/16 E.J. Cleary Medal – Nathan Yates

Mt Clear Captain Nathan Yates has reached rare territory in the Ballarat Cricket Association becoming just the fourth player in history to claim a third EJ Cleary Medal as the first grade competition's most valuable player.

Nathan's outstanding season with bat and ball returned 19 votes, which placed him six clear of the next best.

The victory puts the Nathan alongside Damian Ryan (1972-73, 1973-74 and 1992-93), Trevor McCann (1969-70, 1970-71 and 1977-78) and Brett Milgate (1984-85, 1985-86 and 1991-92) as triple winners of the award.

Nathan, who was named best on ground on six occasions throughout the season, claimed his first EJ Cleary Medal for Mt Clear. His previous triumphs came while playing for East Ballarat in 2008-09 – when he tied with our own Matt Goonan – and 2010-11.

The 34-year-old told the gathering at the Ballarat Golf Club his 2015-16 season performances were similar to those that secured him the medal previously. "The other couple of times I won it, I got runs and wickets, so it helps doing a bit of both – you're always in the game for a little bit," Yates said.

"An individual award, you can't do without your team anyway, so I'd like to thank the Mt Clear boys for being there and supporting me"

Nathan had a sensational 2015-16 home and away campaign returned 556 runs at an average of 46.33



along with 28 wickets coming at an average of 14.14. Nathan was also a strong contributor helping Ballarat win the Division Two at Melbourne Country Week. Congratulations Nathan on a fantastic season.

Mt Clear Second XI Report

For our 2nd XI 2015/16 was a season with lots of firsts. Four new teams entering the Seconds Competition, new faces, a fresh batting and bowling line up and new leadership. It was refreshing to see calm and clear minds from our players which was especially visible in the consistent contributions from the younger members of the team both early and as the season progressed.



As the season commenced hard fought wins through the first months of the season against Dunnstown,

North Ballarat, Wendouree and VRI Delacombe saw some new faces to the Second XI, but experienced Mount Clear cricketers, making an impact within a solid, partnership driven top order. Early key partnerships allowed players in the lower order to enjoy the freedom to score quickly.

Post-Christmas, great team efforts against both East Ballarat and Darley, with younger players coming to the fore, kept our finals chances alive in a tight competition right into the final round.

Unfortunately an experienced Ballan team had us on the back foot early in that last game of the season and as a consequence they took the last spot in the final four. Our season total of 6 wins/3 losses shows us the importance of consistently winning in a tight competition. An impressive campaign overall when we look at the team 12 months prior and see a 75% player turnover to the 2015-2016 season.
